

## Tenkoz' Standard Operating Procedure 100-2: Repacking Bulk or Mini-Bulk Containers with Tenkoz' EPA- Registered Products

1. Make sure that tank/container has been dedicated for one specific Tenkoz' product and has been cleaned as detailed in #4 below. If needed, request a copy of Tenkoz Bulk Tank Cleaning Guidelines.
2. Containers will be filled only with the pertinent Tenkoz' registered product.
3. Customer agrees that it shall not adulterate or otherwise alter, amend, or change in any manner whatsoever the chemical composition of the pesticide and ensures that the formulation conforms to the statement of formulation accepted and approved by the US EPA and provided by Tenkoz.
4. Containers must be inspected to be sure that (1) each container is suitable for the product being placed in it, (2) each container is in good repair and meets all state, federal, and local regulations, and (3) each container is empty and properly cleaned.
5. Only product labels will be used that have been supplied by Tenkoz.
6. Labels will be placed on the containers in conformance with EPA and DOT regulations.
7. On the product labels provided by Tenkoz, there is a blank space after "Net Contents" which must be filled in by designating the quantity of product in the container. This can be accomplished by using either preprinted quantity stickers or by writing in the quantity with waterproof ink. **The correct Net Contents (quantity) must be added to the product label before the product is shipped.**
8. On the product labels provided by Tenkoz, there is a blank space after EPA Est. No. which must be filled in with the **complete** EPA Est. No. at your site where the container is being repacked. The EPA Establishment No. is a unique number assigned to each site registered to produce pesticides and consists of three components as follows: EPA Company Number-State abbreviation-Serial number (identifies the Company, the State in which the site is located, and the Number of the site in that state). For example, if Tenkoz had one production site in Georgia, the EPA Establishment No. would be 55467-GA-001. Adding the EPA Establishment No. can be accomplished by using either your preprinted EPA Est. No. stickers or by writing in your complete EPA Est. No. with waterproof ink. **Your complete EPA Establishment No. must be added to the product label before the product is shipped.**
9. Apply two labels to the tank...one over the valve and one on the opposite side (both need to be filled in with the correct Net Contents and the EPA Est. No.). Always make sure that all old labels have been completely removed.
10. Always note the weight of the empty tank. Include a gross and net weight on the tank.
11. Customer shall indemnify Tenkoz from any liability resulting from customer's sole failure to comply with all applicable local, state, and federal laws, ordinances, standards, rules, and regulations regarding pesticide storage and handling.
12. Customer agrees to review this SOP with all employees who will be involved in repacking containers containing Tenkoz' products.
